The AECSL affiliate campaign will be able to start soon, but they need mobilization assistance and mobilization materials to print.

# 5.3 Annual Campaign

It should be remembered that the joint CMOB on the subject of the mobilization of internships is not

not an internal body of CRUES and that the decisions of that body that relate to CRUES are not restrictive and must be re-adopted in a relevant internal body in order to take effect.
