- The abolition of loans, and the payment of scholarships at one hundred percent (100%)
- That the statute of “réputé temps plein” be extended to include dependent children largely without age restriction for the children.

That the CRUES organises and calls its members to organise manifestations around so-called Quebec.

That the CRUES strongly encourages the associations that follows it call to strike to adopt the following mandate: "That the student association goes on strike from November 9 to 13 whereas at least 40 000 students have a strike mandate in the context of the CRUES's campaign, around so-called Québec."

### **General Unlimited Strike**
